- The Gray Army Air Field Helicopter Parking Apron design-build project at Fort Lewis, Washington, as part of an ID/IQ Contract with the Seattle District. The scope of work included installation of nearly 0.5 million square feet of parking apron on the 10-acre site, taxiway lighting improvements, plus an improved subsurface drainage system and a stormwater collection system.

- Design-build of 16.1 miles of boundary fencing at Fort Wainwright for the Alaska District. Forty-inch pipe rail fencing will prevent vehicle and snowmachine intrusion. Another fence type is standard 6-foot-high military security fencing with barbed wire at the top, crash beam vehicle barriers, and swing gates. The last type is a 6-foot-high combination pipe rail/security fence.
