

Mark Ireland is the Manager of North Slope Gas Upstream Development for ConocoPhillips Alaska, Inc. He is responsible for planning the supply of gas for the Alaska Gas Pipeline. This includes leading the technical and commercial work in preparation of major gas production and sales from CPAI North Slope assets, including Greater Prudhoe, Pt. Thomson, Alpine, NPRA, and any other exploration discoveries.
