Construction Management Education at UAA

- Associate of Applied Science in CM began in 2004.
- 1st graduates in May, 2006.
- AAS-CM was designed as the 1st two years of a bachelor's degree.
- Bachelor's degree will begin in Fall 2007.
- 1st graduates in May, 2008.



Construction Management Education at UAA

- About 125 declared AAS-CM majors.
- About 50 – 60 students actively enrolled this semester.
- CM classes are about 90% full with all entry-level classes filled to 100%.
- Upper-division trial courses are being offered this year for BSCM students.
- Goal: 16 BSCM graduates per year.
