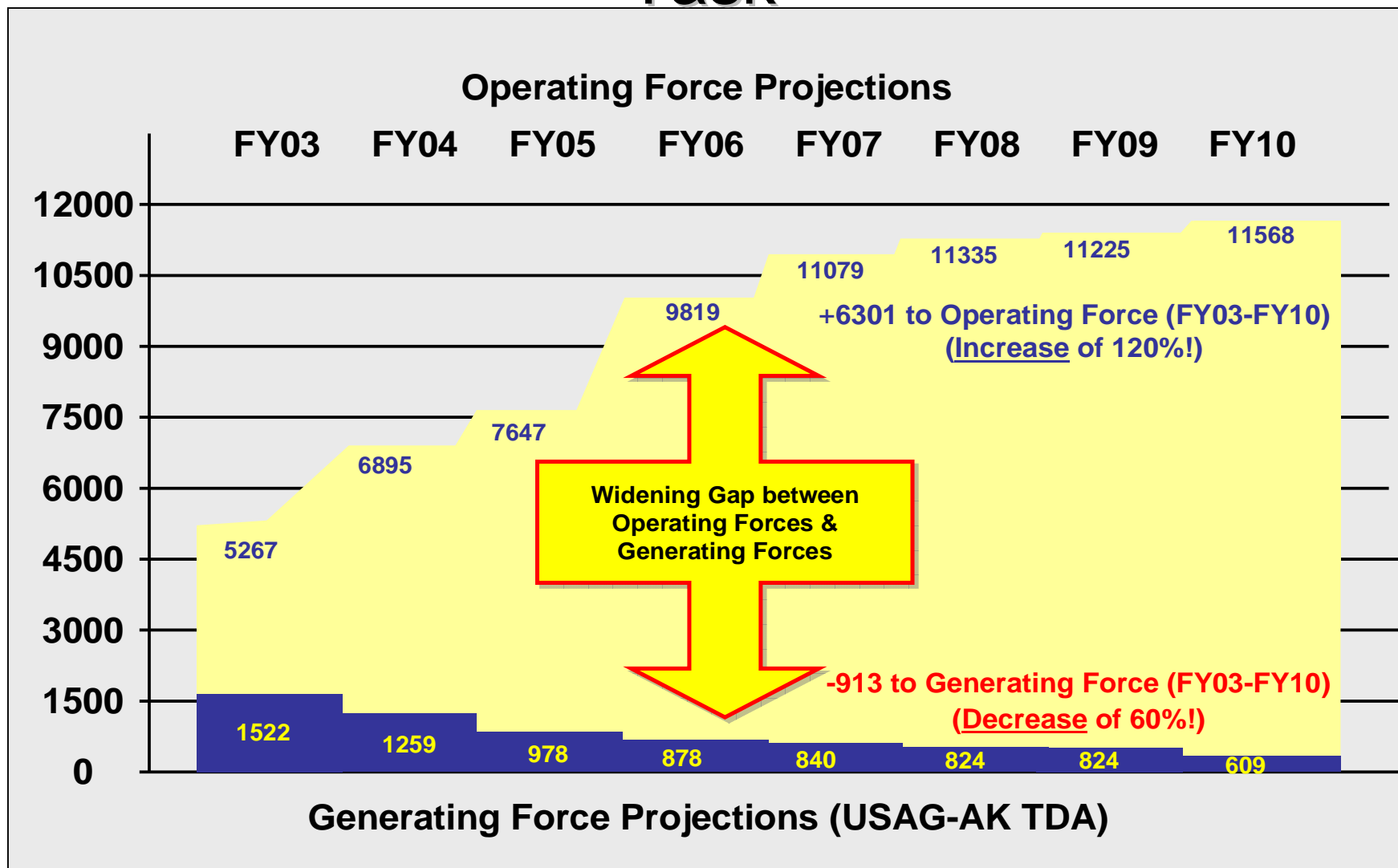

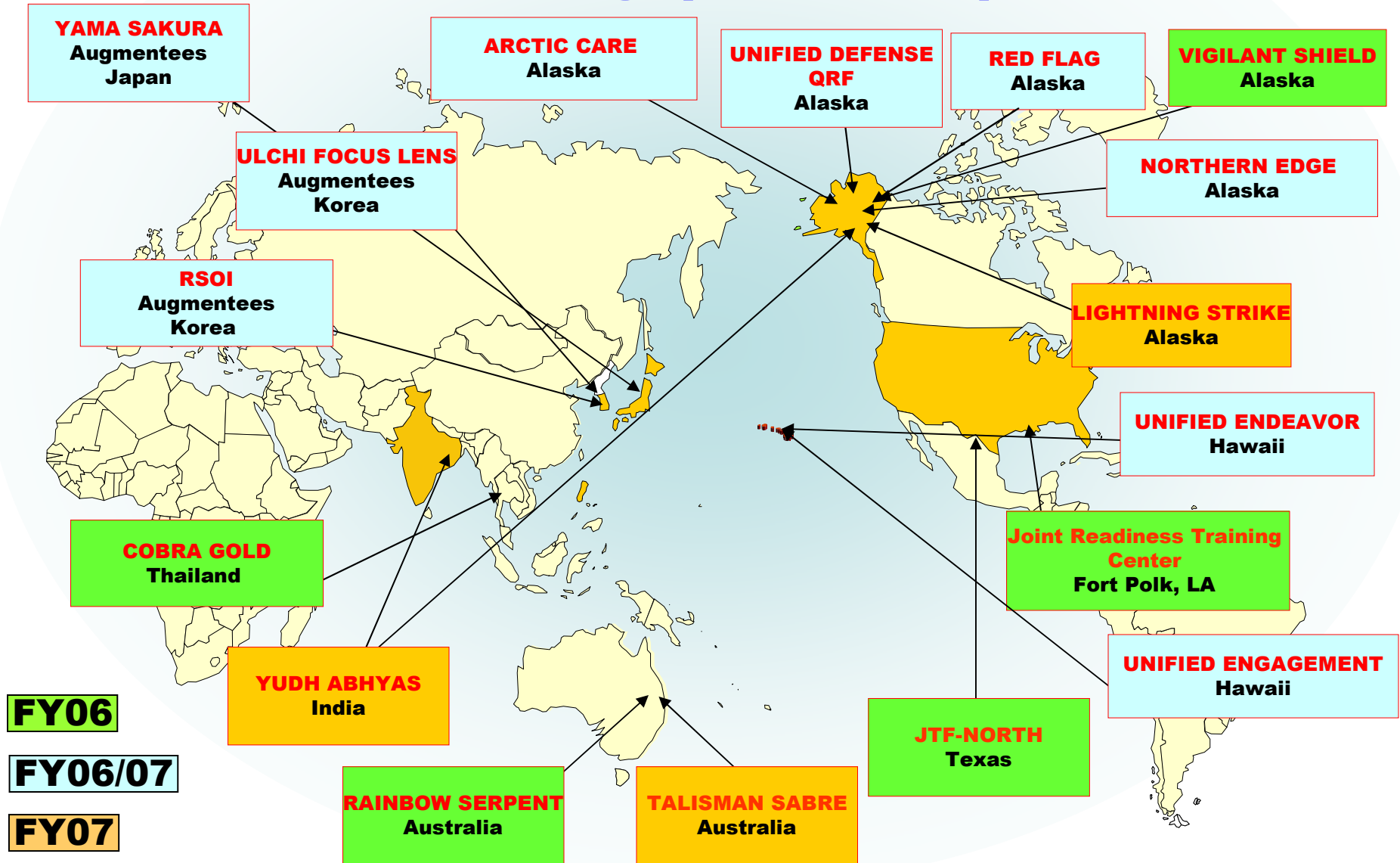

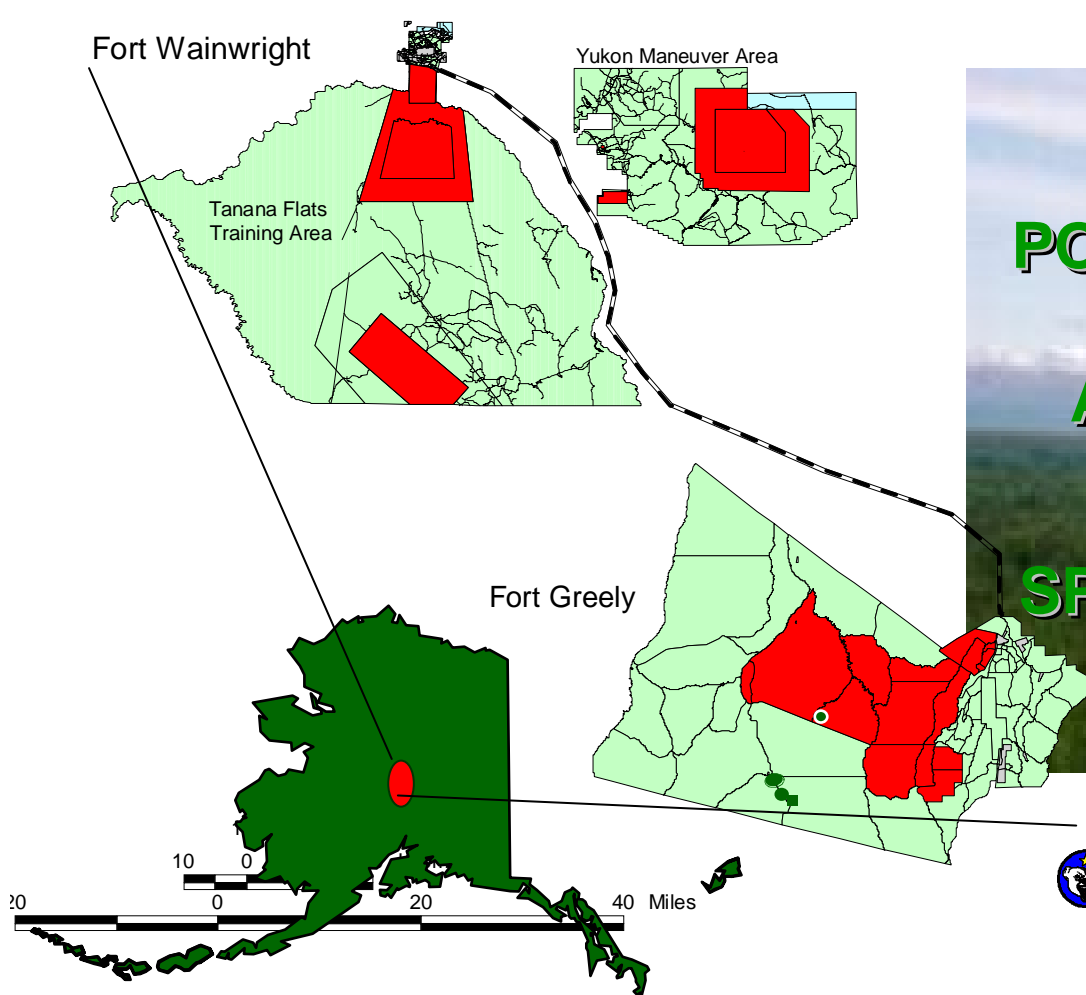
## **FY 05/06 Accomplishments**
